#### Assessments and Club Competitions

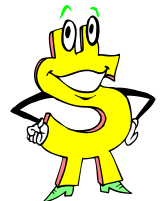
Assessments must be advised to the Head Judge prior to the assessment taking place

The Rule Book requires sheets to be sent to the Head Judge within a week of the Competition or assessment.

Send a copy of all judges sheets and scrutineers sheets, along with a programme or a letter stating who was assessed, and who the assessing judges were. These can be scanned and emailed or posted.

If posted, ensure that the envelope is strong enough to safely transport the sheets, and that the postage is correct. For additional security use a courier or tracking envelope

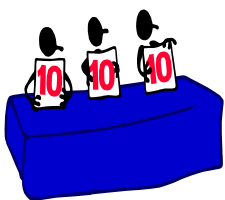


#### Judges
