AGM Guidelines for Delegates and Observers

Delegates speaking: Please adopt the following procedure:

- Indicate to the Executive that you wish to speak
- Stand up when you are called on to speak, identify yourself and your club
- State whether you are "for" or "against" the item under discussion.
- Speak slowly, concisely and to the point. This will reduce the time taken on each item. Make sure you speak clearly enough to be heard by all.
- In an effort to complete this meeting on time, restraints may be placed on speakers by:
 - Restricting the number of times a speaker may speak to each item, or
 - Placing a time restraint on each speaker, or
 - Both (a) & (b) above at the discretion of the Chairperson.
- Make notes about what you are going to say. It could be some time before you are called to speak and notes will help you remember the points you wish to make.

- If the points you wish to make have been covered, you may not need to speak at all.

Voting: There is one vote per club, by a show of hands,.

Observers: You are here as a courtesy to listen and learn, so please adhere to these few simple rules:

- You will be permitted contact with delegates at the breaks only. Please do not approach them, or pass notes while the AGM is convened.
- Please remain in your specified seating area while the AGM is convened.
- If required, a delegate may seek permission from the Council Chairman to allow the observer speaking rights.
