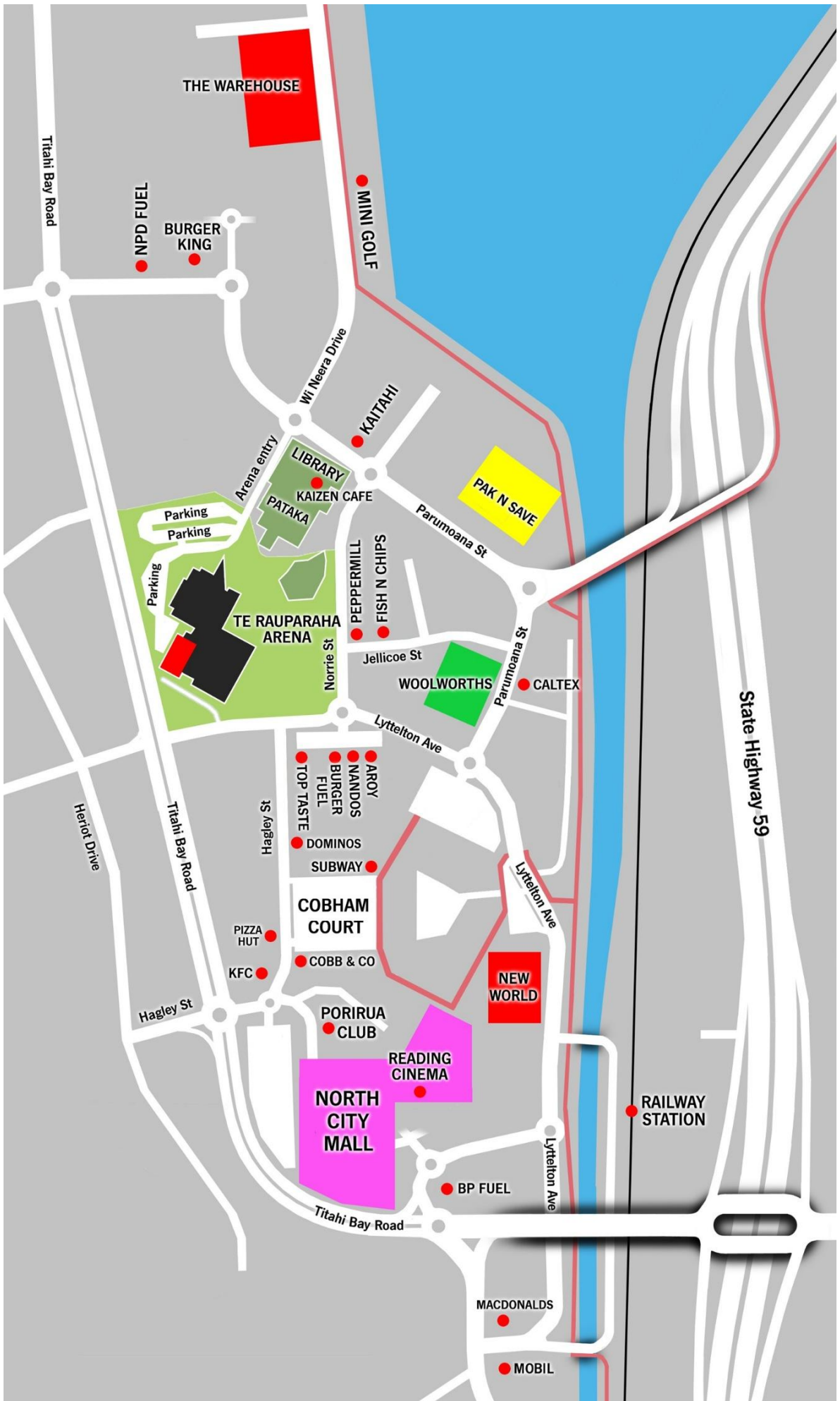
Parking The stadium park has a 2-hour limit during the week. **This does not apply at weekends.**

Food outlets in a 5 minute walk See map on next page for location.

- **Café in the stadium foyer.**
- **Kaizen Café** (in Pataka + Library).
- **Kaitahi.** Food court across the road from the library.
- **Burger King.** By Mega Centre entrance (5 minute walk).
- **Peppermill.** Across the park next to the stadium on the corner of Norrie and Jellicoe Streets.
- **Fish n Chips.** On Jellicoe Street around the corner from Peppermill.
- **Top Taste** (Chinese). Across the park next to the stadium on the corner of Hagley and Lyttelton Streets.
- **Burger Fuel.** Just along from Top Taste.
- **Nando's.** Next to Burger Fuel.
- **Aroy (Korean).** Next to Nando's.
- **Domino's.** Down Hagley Street from Top Taste.
- **Subway.** On Cobham Court, Porirua's central plaza.
- **Cobb & Co.** Corner Cobham Court and Hagley Street.
- **Pizza Hut.** Hagley Street.
- **KFC.** Hagley Street next to Pizza Hut.

Free activities in Porirua

Pataka Art + Museum

WHERE

Next to the road entrance to the stadium.

2 minute walk from the stadium.

HOURS 10am–5pm, 7 days a week.

Police Museum

In the Police College across the road from Aotea Lagoon

ABOUT

Houses a large collection of criminal case items, tells the story about some of New Zealand's more infamous crimes and how they were solved (or not).

WHERE

Royal New Zealand Police College campus.

DRIVING 5 minutes from the stadium.

Same directions as Aotea Lagoon then take the first turn **right** into the college grounds.

HOURS 10am–5pm, 7 days a week
(Not open Good Friday).

Pauatahuni Inlet Reserve

ABOUT

The largest relatively unmodified estuary in the southern North Island with viewing hides, tracks, visitor centre, and picnic area.

WHERE

10 minute drive from the stadium.

3 km north on the motorway (SH59) to Paremata roundabout. Turn right on to SH 58 and follow the foreshore of Pauatahuni Inlet to the next roundabout. Turn sharp left into Pauatahuni village and follow the signs.

Aotea Lagoon

ABOUT

Family friendly reserve with splash pad, Playgrounds, and picnic and BBQ areas. Miniature train rides 12 am to 3pm Sundays (3 per person).

WHERE Papakowhai Road, Porirua

DRIVING 5 minutes from the stadium.

1 km north on the motorway (SH59). Go into the right lane and take exit to Whitford Brown Ave.

Stay in left lane, pass through the traffic lights, and take first turn left after 50 metres.

WALKING 35-minutes from the stadium.

Cambourne Walkway

ABOUT

Return flat trail with bush on one side and Pauatahuni Inlet with iconic boat sheds on the other. Porirua's best walk in a northerly.

WHERE

6 minute drive from the stadium.

3.3 km north on the motorway (SH59). Cross Paremata Bridge and immediately turn right into a public carpark with a container café). Walk left following the shoreline.

Battle Hill Farm Forest Park

HOURS 6am – 6pm April to September

WHERE

15 minute drive from the stadium.

Same route as Pauatahuni Inlet Reserve, 4 km north on Paekakariki Hill Road.

Colonial Knob Walkways

ABOUT

Walking and mountain bike tracks to the top of Colonial Knob. Great option for older kids.

WHERE Raiha Street, Porirua (two entrances).

DRIVING 3 minutes from the stadium

Other Porirua attractions

Pirates Cove

18-hole mini golf course

WHERE

2 Wi Neera Drive, Porirua. Opposite the back of The Warehouse.

4-minute walk from the stadium.

HOURS

Monday-Sunday: 9am to 5pm

WALKING 20 minutes from the stadium

HOURS 10am–2.30pm (last entry).
