2019 AGM Report

Please refer to your delegate/s for a full report. The AGM Minutes and the 2019 Rulebooks are currently being completed and editing. All Rule Book changes are effective immediately. Once completed, the Rule Book can be downloaded from the Association website.

Main Rule changes that were passed at the AGM

- Intermediate Triples age criteria is now 5 17 years.
- There is a new section in the Junior Championship Section 10, Junior Restricted, for ages 5 12 years with an assessment pass of 25%. Restricted is now Section 11, with the age criteria remaining at 5 17 years.
- The Senior Triples age limit is now 40 years and over
- The Closing Date for Junior Entries is now 6th February (Waitangi Day)
- In all Restricted Sections, a judge can deduct up to 2 points as well as giving an "X" when an illegal move is sighted.

Other Items of Note

- New Music in future once a short list has been compiled of newly submitted songs, they will be sent to clubs for comments to be returned within a specified time frame.
- There was discussion about the make-up of teams, with the majority supporting the current Rules.
- The Novice section was discussed, with concern about very new dancers possibly competing against experienced dancers. The Novice section is for first time Nationals dancers and the abilities and ages can vary. It was agreed that the section is a valuable introduction to competition dancing.
- The Council expressed concern about the time it takes for trainee judges to progress through the system. Clubs organising competitions are urged to assist with arm chairing opportunities whenever possible.
- The protection of juniors and coaches was discussed and clubs need to have in place structures that
 protect their members during club activities and coaching sessions. Please contact the Executive for
 specific suggestions about how this can be done.

The Executive Committee thanks all delegates at the 2019 Annual General Meeting; New Zealand rock'n'roll is well served by these committed participants.
