Junior Assessments

To be completed by the 6th February 2020.

When holding assessments, clubs are reminded that the marks of trainee judges officiating are not to be used. Only Association and National Association Judges marks are to be used when assessing for National Competition. The status of your officiating judges can be checked on the website <u>https://www.rocknroll.org.nz/Judges.html</u> or if needed with the Association Head Judge.

Judges at competitions do not need to know who is being assessed but Floor Managers do need to know, so they can check that the dress standard is correct.

All assessments are to be advised to the Association Head Judge prior to their taking place and results must be accompanied by the Assessment Cover Sheets.

As a guide for Nationals, the Association currently reimburses Officials' travel at the rate of 40c per kilometre, or actual expenses as per Rule Book 3.5.
