VENUE and TICKETING

Drifters are releasing today, the venue pre-purchase ticket order form. See either the NZARRA website or Drifters website for the downloadable form.

Venue planning is well underway, however it is not a huge venue so we are concentrating on making sure we provide all pre-purchase ticket holders a seat at a table.

There will be no 'bleachers' and the availability of 'day sale tickets' will be governed by the amount of pre-purchased tickets, so please do not rely on buying a ticket at the venue on the day.

Eftpos will be available as well as a water bottle filling station, at the venue.

COVID-19

Obviously a very topical subject at the moment and we are sure it will still be a part of our lives next year. The Government is making it abundantly clear that there will be some form of Vaccination Passport before the end of the year.

Drifters are envisaging that an event of this scale will require attendees to have a Vaccination Passport (or exemption) but whether this has been extended to under 12's is still unclear so we are just advising to not leave your planning for this eventuality to the last minute.

PARKING

Ample on site parking with a site map which can be found on our website.

There will be a parking restriction in front of the main entrance which will be reserved for Officials and vendors only.

Please note; we will have a 'one way' traffic flow system in place at the school.

The main entrance which is off Ellicott Road, is an entrance only so the exit from the school grounds is via Nyanza Street which is onto Waimarie Street, and then back onto Ellicott Road.

MOTOR HOMES

For those wishing to stay in a self-contained motor home, the charge for the weekend of the 15th - 17th April will be \$25, which can be paid at the registration desk inside the main entrance to the venue.
